#### Veteran Card & Lapel Pin

The Veteran Card is available to anyone who has served in the Australian Defence Force with at least one day of continuous full-time service.

Eligible Reservists, including those engaged in Disaster Relief Service, Border Protection Service, or those involved in serious servicerelated training accidents, will also be able to request a Veteran Card.

All existing DVA health card holders (Gold or White) and concession card holders (Orange) do not need to apply. Your existing service and entitlements are on record.

Veteran applicants, new to DVA, can apply for the new Veteran Card by creating a MyService account and,

there, request a Veteran Card.

The new look cards will be issued over the coming months.

You can request a Veteran Lapel Pin using MyService.
