Following is an article from an RSL Handbook from 1965 the ANZAC Jubilee Issue:

HORSES OF WAR

It is estimated that 958,600 horses and mules were killed in the Great War.

Of the British horses, 51,308 were killed by gunshot and 67,532 wounded.

One hundred and seventy-eight were killed by gas and 1,868 rendered unfit from the same cause.

The most famous war horse was David, of the 107th Battery, R.F.A. He served throughout the South African War, 1899-1902, and as a wheeler in a gun team went to France in August, 1914. He served for the duration. He qualified for the Queen's Medal with four clasps, King's Medal with two clasps, the 1914 Star with bar, War, Victory and Long Service Medals, and had 4 wound stripes.

The Duchess of Portland took David to her Home of Rest for Old Horses and he died in his sleep in 1921.

Of the 169,000 horses which left Australia for war service only one came back. He was "Sandy", the favorite charger of General Bridges who died from wounds received at Anzac and who is buried at Duntroon, near the Royal Military College which he founded.

Sandy's head is preserved in the Australian War Memorial Museum at Canberra.
