Ingredients: 1 tin mango slices in natural juice(425gm)
500gms Mixed Fruit
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ teasp bi-carb soda
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups SR Flour
2 Eggs (lightly beaten)
Grease lge loaf tin, combine undrained mango (roughly Chopped), mixed fruit & water in saucepan, bring to boil, simmer uncovered for 1 min, let cool, stir in sifted flour & bi-carb with eggs, mix well, spoon into loaf tin, bake in moderate oven (160) for 1 hour, let cool in tin.... ENJOY
