Date	18 Brigade Movements and Events
2-Mar-42	Left Suez Eqypt aboard 3 Ships
20-Mar-42	Convoy arrived Fremantle Western Australia
28-Mar-42	Disembarked at Adelaide to Camp just outside of Gawler South Australia
16-Apr-42	Brigade moves from Gawler SA by train and vehicle to Tenterfield NSW
26-Apr-42	Brigade move to Tenterfield NSW completed
20-May-42	Advance Brigade party sent to Kilcoy Qld
24-May-42	Brigade move to Kilcoy Qld completed in 2 convoys of vehicles
30-Jun-42	Governor General of Australia Lord Gowrie VC visits 18 Brigade units at Kilcoy
12-14 July 1942	18 Brigade conducted combined arms field exercise in Coorey-Pomona area with other 7 Division units
15-Jul-42	18 Brigade returned to Kilcoy area Camps
4-Aug-42	18 Brigade receives Divisional Warning Order prepare to move out
6-Aug-42	At 0030 hrs 18 Brigade advance party boards waiting ships
	At 1150 hrs ships depart Newstead Quay Brisbane Qld
8-Aug-42	HMAS Arunta leaves convoy for Townsville and is replaced with 1 Sloop and and 2 Corvettes
12-Aug-42	Disembarked on pontoon wharf at Gili Gili, Milne Bay
24-Aug-42	First enemy air raid attacks with between 8-14 fighters
25-Aug-42	Enemy troops land by barges on adjacent Goodenough Island
26-Aug-42	Enemy troops land by barges on at night north of Milne Bay allied held positions and make first contact with militia 61st batallion
7-Sep-42	Enemy Japs withdraw beaten

Sadly, on the 4 September we lost John French VC for his actions during this battle from the 2/9<sup>th</sup> Australian Infantry Batallion.
